

**COAL CITY VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
PUBLIC HEARING
OCTOBER 24, 2018**

At 7 p.m. on Wednesday, October 24, 2018, Mayor Terry Halliday called to order the Public Hearing of the Coal City Village Board in the boardroom of the Village Hall. Roll call-Trustees Ross Bradley, David Spesia, and Sarah Beach. Absent were Neal Nelson, Dan Greggain and Tim Bradley.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is for the proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing Rehabilitation Program. NCICG (North Central Illinois Council of Government) is assisting the Village in obtaining this State grant.

Kevin Lindeman from NCICG described the grant application and process. The application is in the amount of \$314,552 and includes eight houses in the Village that qualify for the low to moderate income grant. Mr. Lindeman described the project area and the qualifications. The grant may be applied for every two years. The application will be submitted to the State on November 2nd with 100% of the funds being used by the residents. The award will be announced in the spring and this Public Hearing is another step in the grant process.

Questions from the audience included:

- Qualifying applicants-based on income and need
- Notification process
