ORDINANCE NO. 17-32

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 OF THE VILLAGE CODE AMENDING RESTRICTED PARKING TO INCLUDE TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS ON PHEASANT, EAGLE, AND HUNTERS RUN

WHEREAS, the Village of Coal City is authorized by the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-208, to regulate traffic by means of traffic control signs; and

WHEREAS, the Coal City Police Department has recommended limiting the parking within the neighborhood adjacent to the Middle School during certain event times utilizing temporary signage; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Coal City desires to give notice to the residents of the Village prior to altering the traffic pattern; and

WHEREAS, the Coal City Police Department has monitored utilization of residential parking both during and times unaffected by special events in order to make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Trustees of the Village of Coal City as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Amendment. Schedule I: Limited Parking of Section 78-1 shall include temporary restrictions when indicated by posted temporary signage on 1.) all side of Eagle Court, 2.) the east side of Pheasant, and 3.) the north side of Hunters Run between Pheasant and Quail Streets.

Section 3. Notice of Proper Signage. The Chief of Police of the Village of Coal City, or his designee, shall place signs along the curb lines to provide adequate direction for motorists.

Section 4. Effectiveness. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


