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May 1<sup>st</sup> through June 1<sup>st</sup> Public Works will clean and larvacide storm catch basins.

It will take approximately 300 days to step clean sanitary sewer lines, attached is a map with four different zones. Public Works will start with zone one.

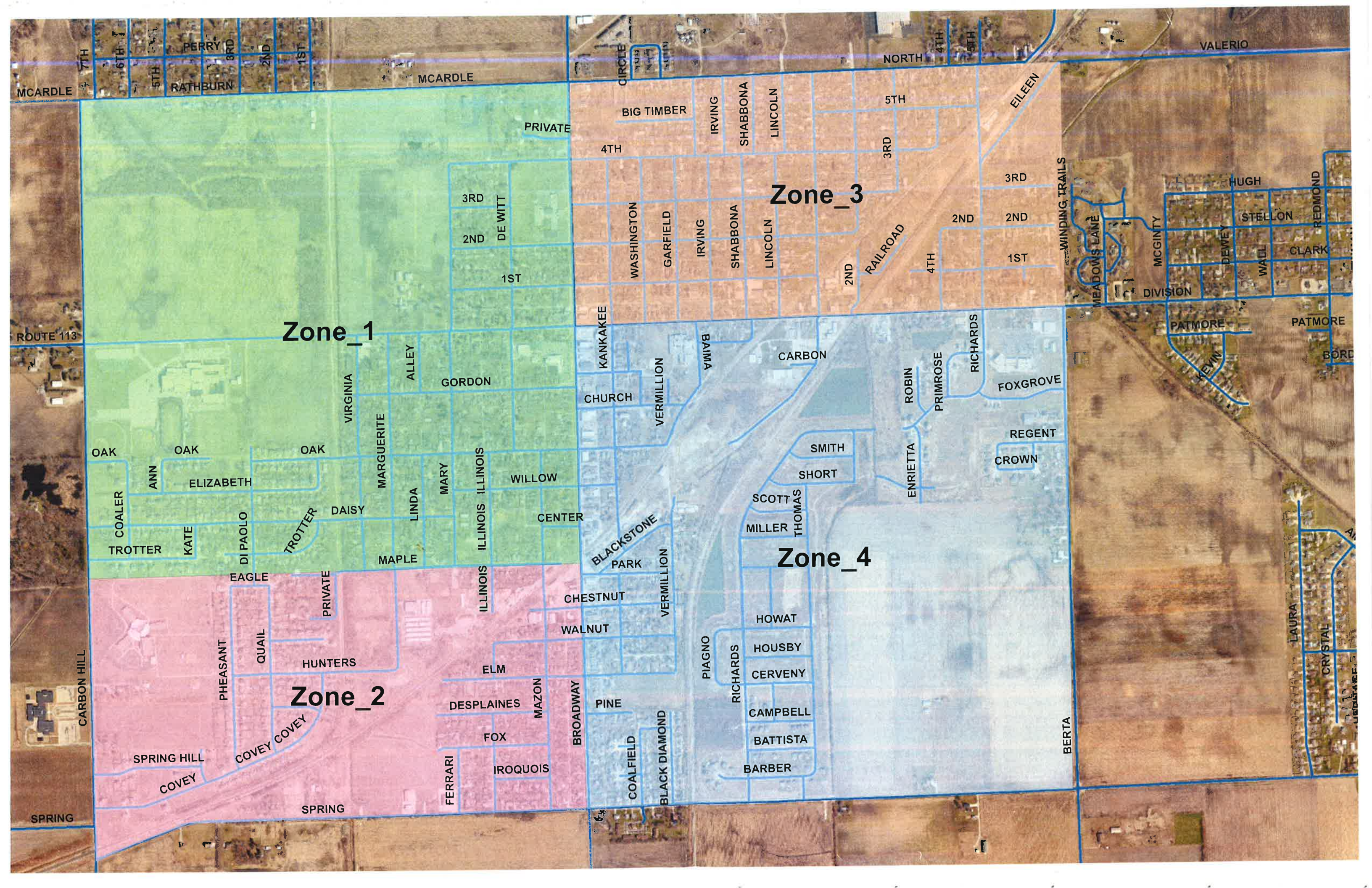
