


**COAL CITY VILLAGE BOARD
PUBLIC HEARING
DECEMBER 12, 2018**

At 7 p.m. on Wednesday, December 12, 2018, Mayor Terry Halliday called to order the Public Meeting of the Coal City Village Board in the boardroom of the Village Hall. Roll call-Trustees Neal Nelson, Ross Bradley, Dan Greggain, David Spesia, Tim Bradley and Sarah Beach. Also in attendance were Matt Fritz, village administrator, Attorney Mark Heinle, Police Chief Tom Best, and Matt Halloran from Chamlin Engineering.

Mr. Fritz stated that this Public Hearing was in regards for the property tax levy for SSA #2 (Special Service Area) for the 4-acre industrial park and the Union Pacific lead tracks on Reed Road and South Broadway. The Property is owned by two entities and this tax levy is specific to those property owners only. An ordinance has been prepared for approval by the Board in their regular meeting tonight. The amount to be levied is \$431,450.00.

There were no questions or comments from the public. T. Bradley moved to adjourn the Public Hearing, second by R. Bradley. Roll call-Ayes; Nelson, Bradley, Greggain, Spesia, Bradley and Beach. Nays; none. Motion carried. The Public Hearing was adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
