## PUBLIC HEARING DECEMBER 8, 2021

At 7 p.m. on Wednesday, December 8, 2021, Mayor Terry Halliday called to order the Public Hearing of the Coal City Village Board in the boardroom of the Village Hall. Roll call-Trustees Dave Togliatti, Ross Bradley, Dan Greggain, Dave Spesia, Tim Bradley and Sarah Beach. Also in attendance was Matt Fritz, village administrator, attorney Mark Heinle, Chris Harseim, Chief of Police and Ryan Hansen from Chamlin Engineering.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is for consideration of Ordinance 21-43 setting the property tax levy for the Amended SSA #2 (Special Service Area) in Coal City. Mr. Fritz stated that the property owners were notified of these proceedings. The property consists of three separate PIN numbers and the amount to be levied exceeds 105% which necessitates this Truth in Taxation hearing. The amount of \$501,474.17 will be levied, payable in the 2022 taxes. This is for payment of the alternate revenue bonds for the ILPCC (Inland Logistics Port Coal City) original SSA #2.

T. Bradley moved to adjourn the Public Hearing, second by Spesia. Roll call-Ayes; Togliatti, Bradley, Greggain, Spesia, Bradley and Beach. Nays; none. Motion carried and the Public Hearing was adjourned at 7:04 p.m.
