


**COAL CITY VILLAGE BOARD MEETING  
PUBLIC HEARING  
DECEMBER 14, 2022**

At 7:04 pm. on Wednesday, December 14, 2022, Mayor Terry Halliday called to order the Coal City Village Board Public Hearing in the boardroom of the Village Hall. Roll call-Trustees Ross Bradley, Dan Greggain, Dave Spesia, Tim Bradley and Sarah Beach. Absent; Trustee Dave Togliatti. Also in attendance was Matt Fritz, village administrator, Police Chief Chris Harseim, Ryan Hansen from Chamlin Engineering and attorney Mark Heinle.

Connie Buchanan, representing the North Central Illinois Council of Government (NCICG) presented information regarding the Village's participation on a new Housing Rehabilitation Program through the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunities (DCEO) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). These grant funds, \$650,000.00, will revitalize qualified homes in the community, for major, moderate and minor repairs. NCICG are assisting the Village in obtaining the grant funds. At least ten homes will benefit from this grant. Ms. Buchanan explained the process to the Board and public regarding qualifying homes, process and procedures.

This is one of the first steps in the grant application process. The Village should receive notification if they have received the CDBG grant within six months.

Greggain moved to adjourn the Public Hearing, second by T. Bradley. Roll call-Ayes; Bradley, Greggain, Spesia, Bradley and Beach. Nays; none. Absent; Togliatti. Motion carried and the Public Hearing was adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
